**Footnotes**

RUSTY'S RED BOY was sent to contest the pace from inside, roused into the stretch, drew clear and was kept to urging until the waning yards. PIRATE'S ON LINE gradually angled in on the backstretch, gained the rail midway on the turn, floated out a bit entering the stretch, moved back to the rail approaching the furlong marker, was all out under steady urging and edged ahead for second nearing the wire. BEAUCOUP GOLD was hustled along to vie for the lead between rivals, moved in beside RUSTY'S RED BOY into the turn, drifted out to path four into the lane, drifted some more nearing the eighth pole, held a straight path until the final sixteenth then gradually lugged in. TIP FROM SKIP a step slow at the start, was steadied behind traffic shortly after the break, gradually moved to the outside on the backstretch, angled inside on the bend, altered out two wide leaving the quarter pole, was forced to alter out further upper stretch, advanced to the final furlong then could only pull away from the rest. DEMIKON forced in some at the start, raced in midpack between horses, moved to the rail nearing the turn, improved his position, was checked when his path narrowed upper stretch and kept tight in hand until inside the final furlong. MOKEE came in a bit at the break, gradually backed up between rivals, was three wide into the turn, fanned out to path six leaving the bend, found himself behind FIRM MINER, altered inside that one upper stretch and passed between tired ones. SPOOKY SUNDAY displayed early speed from outside, faded three wide on the bend, lugged in upper stretch, was corrected inside the last eighth and continued to give way. ATS GOOD taken in hand before finishing the first sixteenth, was kept under a hold until nearing the turn, was just off the inside on the bend, swung out widest entering the lane and had no late bid. FIRM MINER a contender between horses early, was forced to the inside entering the turn, altered outside PIRATE'S ON LINE approaching the five-sixteenths pole on the bend, began to tire, drifted out to path six into the stretch and steadily faded.
