Footnotes

OUST settled, gradually progressed three wide between rivals on the backstretch, was just off the inside entering the second bend, swung three wide midway on that bend, took the lead near the quarter pole, was clear and angled in some leaving the turn, roused at that point, steadily drew away from the others and was kept to urging until near the wire. FUTURISTIC hesitated then reared up at the break, saved ground on the first turn, altered out for room midway on the backstretch, was four wide through the second bend, all out in the lane and caught MARKSMILK IS WHITE nearing the wire. MARKSMILK IS WHITE also settled early, advanced four wide on the backstretch, moved with OUST after a half mile to threaten four wide nearing the quarter pole, was three wide leaving the second turn, moved clear for second upper stretch, lugged in some under steady right-handed pressure, did not have enough left to hold off FUTURISTIC but was easily best of the others. LOGAN'SSHOREBREEZE showed first, was soon chasing the early speed from outside, angled in to be just off the inside on the first turn, took the rail on the backstretch, fanned out some entering the stretch, altered out three wide inside the last eighth and passed some tired ones. SINGALONGWITH BERT hustled to contest the pace two wide, flattened out for the drive. SUNDAY SAINT vied for the lead inside for six furlongs, could not stay with OUST leaving the second turn and also flattened out through the lane. BLACK DIAMOND BAY retreated just off the inside once straightened on the backstretch, was checked briefly when FUTURISTIC came out at the nine-sixteenths marker, continued to fade, was eased the last quarter mile and walked off.
