WILDMAN MAC was prominent while toward the outside from the beginning, four wide on the turn, was carried out to path six entering the lane, rallied the last furlong and got up in time. ILLINI DESTINY sent from inside, was jostled and checked after travelling the first sixteenth, continued along the rail, gained the advantage upper stretch, fought gamely but was outfinished. CORNER BOY contested the pace between rivals, did not stay with HALLELUJAH SQUARE while three wide on the turn, drifted out to path five into the lane, came back to duel on the front end, did not have enough late but proved easily best of the rest. ROBYN THE TILL in the second flight from outside, lost ground five and six wide taking the bend and lacked a rally as he steadily angled in through the stretch. HALLELUJAH SQUARE made a small leap from the gate, was hustled up and gradually forced to jostle briefly with ILLINI DESTINY after leaving the five-furlong marker, moved clear just off the inside on the turn, floated out to path three into the stretch, challenged from both sides and wore down. SIR MILLER was soon far back, picked up his pace along the rail on the bend, made up some ground in the lane, was steadied behind ROBYN THE TILL in the waning yards and altered out. FIREY NEW LOVE angled in shortly after the break, crowding those inside him, was well placed between horses, two wide taking the turn but flattened out for the drive.
