CORNER GIRL soon found herself boxed in behind the early speed, gained a clear path three wide midway on the turn, was roused at the top of the lane, began to drift out approaching the furlong marker, was straightened near the sixteenth pole, gained the advantage soon after and gradually edged ahead under a drive. FAITH'S FORTUNE showed first, disputed the pace from outside, two wide through the bend, moved clear upper stretch but did not have enough left the last sixteenth. TAP DAZZLER away slowly, trailed from inside, moved out widest after travelling the first eighth, lost ground five wide into the bend, angled in some leaving the turn, gradually altered out as CORNER GIRL came out in the lane and was closing in for second deep stretch. STRONG N TRUE was sent to vie for the lead from inside but wore down for the drive. SHAYLINS DANCER gradually angled in on the backstretch, saved ground taking the turn and failed to have a stretch rally. LONELY HUNTER raced in the second flight three wide on the backstretch, angled out some into the bend, began to tire, swung out further into the lane and lugged in deep stretch. TWO ELAINES also gradually moved to the inside on the backstretch, was just off the rail through the turn and unresponsive in the stretch.
