Footnotes

DANCER'S DREAM soon had the lead and angled in to be just off the inside, shook off TIZAWISH under a drive upper stretch, was kept to urging until nearing the final sixteenth then ridden out. TIZAWISH broke alertly, was hustled along and moved to the inside, chased DANCER'S DREAM from along the rail, could not stay with that one in the lane but was unchallenged for second. KATIE'S WILD ONE brushed at the start, soon had the inside, was checked when his path was taken nearing the half pole, continued to stay in contention while still along the rail, swung out three wide for a clear path leaving the bend, lacked the extra needed for the drive but stayed clear for the show. LOGOLD'S LUCK brushed with KATIE'S WILD ONE at the start, was void of speed between horses, two wide through the bend, lugged in a bit upper stretch and had no late bid. ZULU WARRIOR checked briefly behind KATIE'S WILD ONE shortly after the start, moved to the outside then back in on the backstretch, saved ground taking the turn, altered in some when LOGOLD'S LUCK came in upper stretch, moved outside that one after entering the last eighth and finished evenly. AMARILLO SOL a step slow at the break, was widest throughout and showed little. The rider of KATIE'S WILD ONE lodged an objection claiming interference from TIZAWISH nearing the half mile pole. After their review, the stewards disqualified TIZAWISH for coming in without being clear of KATIE'S WILD ONE and placed him third.
