Footnotes

NINA NINA in midpack early from inside, angled out on the turn, came six wide into the stretch, was altered out nearing the eighth pole for a clear path, all out the rest of the way and got up in time. CHA CHING rated from outside on the backstretch, commenced her bid three wide on the turn, fanned to path five entering the lane, was forced out some upper stretch, gained the advantage nearing the eighth pole, was clear with a sixteenth left but outfinished in a game effort. CAPE ADARE was gradually angled in on the backstretch, saved ground through the bend, made a strong move along the rail in the stretch but was too late. FOILED YOU TOO ran in midpack just outside NINA NINA on the backstretch, had the rail on the turn, rallied upper stretch to threaten with a furlong to go but gradually drifted out in the late going and could not improve her position. DEBS GONE POSTAL chased the early speed from between rivals, commenced her bid three wide on the turn, gained the lead while also being forced out some upper stretch but did not have enough left inside the final furlong. PECAN crowded at the start, was without speed between rivals, four wide on the turn, lost ground fanning to the middle of the track into the stretch and lacked a significant response. CARTWHEEL was hustled along from outside to set the pace, drew clear and stayed just off the inside on the turn, floated out to path three entering the lane, drifted out some upper stretch then flattened out between horses the last eighth. CHARMS DIANE fractious in the gate, broke in the air, was gradually angled out, five to seven wide taking the bend, angled in upper stretch and had little to offer. ADDIE KAY broke outward, was soon well back, saved ground and lacked a stretch bid. E BAY DUBAI was an early factor from inside, could not stay with CARTWHEEL on the turn, swung out to path four into the stretch, began to fade from between horses, became lame, was eased late and walked off.
