SHAKKARENA advanced inside to gain the advantage midway on the backstretch, was clear nearing the bend, just off the rail leaving the turn, was put to a drive upper stretch, steadily lengthened her lead and was kept to a drive until nearing the sixteenth pole. HALF MOON BEAUTY chased the early speed from outside, was two wide on the turn, fanned out some for the drive, took over second upper stretch and drifted out some deep stretch as she battled to hold her position. FLITTER FLATTER in midpack along the rail on the backstretch, made up ground on the turn, dueled for second through the stretch, could not get past HALF MOON BEAUTY in the late going but proved clearly best of the others. VINDICATION ISLAND broke outward, bumping REBA NELL, was without early speed just off the inside, swung outside into the turn, was four then five wide taking the bend and failed to have a significant stretch response. REBA NELL was bumped and stumbled at the break, was soon well back, improved position three wide on the turn, fanned out further for the drive and lacked a rally. LEILANA hesitated at the start, was void of speed, through hustled along from outside, moved to the inside entering the bend and passed a couple more tire in the lane. SCATS HONOUR showed first, was soon engaged from inside, could not stay with SHAKKARENA nearing the turn, began to tire from path three leaving the bend, found herself behind HALF MOON BEAUTY into the lane, altered in some upper stretch and steadily gave way. MIAZA steadily faded from outside, stayed in path four through the bend, angled out further upper stretch and continued to retreat.
