Footnotes

DAWNS MISTAKE sent to inside to contest the pace, battled through the lane and edged ahead late. SHE'S BONAFIDE showed first, set a pressured pace from outside, was two wide taking the turn, all out under a steady drive in the stretch, did not have enough in the waning yards but was clearly second best. MARIA DE SLEW advanced between rivals on the backstretch to move clear for third entering the turn, saved ground on the bend, angled out three wide at the top of the lane, drifted out some under left-handed pressure with a sixteenth to go, was corrected and finished evenly. ROSIE'S PRAYER an early factor between rivals, was two then three wide on the turn, moved to the rail entering the lane, lacked a rally and finished evenly. APPEALING RED BIRD shook her head several times as she left the gate, soon trailed, saved ground and failed to menace. RED HOT REDHEAD a contender from outside on the backstretch, faded widest on the turn.
