Footnotes

PASS THE MONEY brushed with ALICIA'S PRETY BOY at the break, soon contested the pace from inside, moved clear upper stretch, gradually drifted out as he weakened the last eighth but narrowly held on. KEYSTONE KID altered out widest for room nearing the bend, swung five wide into the lane, rallied, gradually altered out as PASS THE MONEY came out inside the last eighth, came up short but was clearly second best. SPURTABILITY trailed, began to advance along the rail on the turn, fought for third in the stretch and edged ahead inside the final furlong. SABAGO prominent between horses, was steadied when his path narrowed nearing the turn, waited for room while boxed in just off the rail through the bend, did not keep up entering the stretch, fought for third just off the inside but did not have enough in the waning yards. PEDESTAL broke well but soon dropped back, had the rail leaving the turn, fanned out some into the lane, altered in some inside the last eighth for a clear path and passed tired ones. HONKY TONK GOLD vied for the lead from outside, was three wide on the turn, began to yield into the stretch, bumped with ALICIA'S PRETY BOY approaching the furlong marker, angled outside at that pool and continued to yield. ALICIA'S PRETY BOY brushed with PASS THE MONEY at the start and bobbed, quickly recovered to contest the pace between rivals, also began to wear down into the lane, bumped with HONKY TONK GOLD upper stretch and gradually faded. REVERENTIAL soon moved to the inside, swung out taking the bend, came widest into the stretch and had little to offer.
