Footnotes

SUNDAY DREAMS bumped just after the break, vied for the early lead just off the inside, moved clear along the rail on the turn, was under a drive the last eighth and maintained full control. CLARA'S GROVE pressed from between rivals, was boxed inside leaving the turn, gained a clear path just off the rail into the stretch, drew off for second but could not close the gap on the leader. DOLCETTO displayed early speed from outside, could not stay with SUNDAY DREAMS while two wide on the bend, floated out further into the lane, was no match for the top pair but remained unchallenged for the show. CHICAGO CALI trailed from outside, passed some tired rivals two wide on the bend, fanned out some for the drive and lacked a significant response. SPECIAL LOVER in contention just off the inside on the backstretch, faded on the turn. FANNING THE FLAME drifted out just past the gate to bump SUNDAY DREAMS, chased from inside, could not keep up on the turn, was steadied as she tried to drift out leaving the bend, floated out widest, once clear, entering the lane, bore out the last furlong and was eased.
