Footnotes

SASHITA bobbled a bit at the break, moved up from outside to vie for the lead before finishing a quarter mile, had the advantage two wide on the turn, was all out in the lane, drifted out a bit inside the last furlong, was quickly corrected and held off LADY DI'S DREAMER. The latter, prominent from inside, swung out three wide for a clear path entering the stretch, closed well but came up a bit short. BETTER SAFE broke in stride and quickly moved clear and to the rail, was challenged before finishing a quarter mile, fought gamely but slowly yielded in the lane. PLEASE BOUNDARY without early speed, had the rail on the bend, came off the inside some for the drive, made a strong move the last furlong but was too late. CAMP FAIRFAX R N advanced between rivals to contest the pace nearing the end of the first quarter mile, could not keep up while three then four wide taking the turn and also found best stride too late inside the final furlong. MINNIE SUNSHINE a step slow at the start, was soon well back, was widest through the turn but showed a willingness to run deep stretch. HALF MOON BEAUTY also a step slow at the break, was steadied behind traffic a few strides from the gate, also stayed well off the inside throughout and lacked a stretch bid.
