FAST ALBERT rated off the inside the first half mile, angled out widest midway on the backstretch, steadily advanced, moved clear from path three on the second bend, was put to a drive upper stretch and continued to open up under steady handling. MAUR HILL away a bit slowly, was unhurried and soon far back, commenced his bid going to the second turn, had the rail into that bend, swung between horses leaving the quarter pole, split another pair of rivals midstretch and pulled away as second best soon after. KID RIGO was sent to set a pressured pace from inside, could not stay with FAST ALBERT on the second turn, fought for second to just inside the last furlong then did not have enough left. DAPPLED broke outward, vied for the lead three wide on the backstretch, two wide on the second bend, battled for second after FAST ALBERT took over but also wore down the final eighth. SOON was boxed in behind KID RIGO for a half mile, failed to keep up going to the second turn, angled out on that bend and was empty for the drive. NICKY'S DELIGHT pressed from between horses but faded along the rail on the second turn.
