PERFECT CUP OF TEA bumped with JOYCE G at the start, came off the rail some midway on the first turn while being rated off the early speed, commenced her bid nearing the second bend, gained the advantage two wide into the stretch, drew clear under a drive, was kept to steady urging and held off STARIANA. The latter, settled outside, was in path four entering the backstretch, picked up her pace into the second turn, progressed from path three on the bend, floated out some entering the lane, steadily closed the gap, came up short but was easily second best. RUN MAMA BEARE RUN was quickly clear, took the rail early in the first turn, was challenged on the second bend, all out in the lane but could only just last for third. JOYCE G bumped with PERFECT CUP OF TEA at the start, settled just off the rail, made up some ground as she advanced on the second turn, floated out to path three for the stretch run and lacked the extra needed. SONGANDDANCELADY void of speed while just outside JOYCE G through the early going, did not stay with the latter into the second bend, floated out to path four entering the lane, was allowed to coast and gradually drifted out the last furlong. SHAKEEL'S BEST chased three wide, moved to the inside at the halfway point and gave way on the second turn.
