Footnotes

SHICAGO SENSATION hustled along just off the inside, moved clear nearing the half mile marker, was just off the inside on the bend, took the rail into the lane, put to a drive inside the final sixteenth and held off U K WILDCAT. The latter advanced along the rail to help prompt the early pace, came off the inside some for the stretch run, was all out, drew clear for second but could not close the gap on the leader. GETUPANDBOOGIE bumped with GREAT BONUS at the start, soon trailed while toward the outside, progressed just off the rail on the turn, altered in for a clear path at the quarter pole, took over third upper stretch, was no match for the top pair the last eighth but clearly best of the rest. BLACKHAWK RED jostled briefly nearing the half mile marker, was steadied, gradually altered in, steadied slightly when his path was taken at the quarter pole, altered out two wide for the stretch run and passed a couple tired rivals. LUCKY CHANGE was prominent three wide for more than three furlongs but flattened out for the drive. GREAT BONUS bumped with GETUPANDBOOGIE at the break, soon found himself in tight quarters between rivals, jostled briefly with BLACKHAWK RED approaching the half mile pole, was also steadied, just off the inside with a quarter mile to go, fanned four wide into the stretch and steadily faded. ZIMANY was a contender from outside on the backstretch but gave way four wide on the turn.
