Footnotes

MOMENTARILY rated from outside, came into the lane six wide, was all out under a steady drive and got up in time. CAVANAUGH soon vied for the lead between rivals, gained the rail on the turn, floated out a bit entering the lane, drew clear but began to wear down the final sixteenth. TURN N' FIRE in contention early, was just off the inside taking the bend, rallied in the stretch, angled out looking for a clear path with a sixteenth left and jostled briefly with ANGEL FIRST CLASS in the waning yards as he closed the gap. MIDNITE KID prominent from inside, was outrun into the turn, swung out, came five wide entering the lane, was also making up ground deep stretch and was bumped approaching the wire. ANGEL FIRST CLASS settled early, picked up his pace just off the inside on the turn, swung three wide for the drive, rallied between rivals, was forced out after entering the final sixteenth, jostled between TURN N' FIRE and MIDNITE KID nearing the wire and checked. HIGH HEIR broke in stride, was soon challenged from outside, two wide on the turn, floated out to path four into the stretch, slowly began to yield, lost his path inside the last sixteenth and was altered out. CHASIN THE GIRLS was soon well back, as well as well off the rail, angled in on the turn and had no late bid. There was a stewards' inquiry into the race deep stretch. After their review, TURN N' FIRE was disqualified and placed fifth for coming out without being clear inside the sixteenth marker and forcing ANGEL FIRST CLASS into MIDNITE KID, causing the former to take up.
