ROSIE MY ROSIE gradually angled out on the backstretch, was five wide into the second turn, angled in some as she went for the lead leaving that bend, gained a slight advantage upper stretch with little asking, was put to a drive in the waning yards and shook off GENOVEVA (MEX). The latter advanced from inside on the backstretch, was boxed in and waited for room approaching the second turn, squeezed through two wide early in that turn, moved ahead, was challenged from outside as she took the rail upper stretch, fought gamely to the wire, did not have enough left but was easily best of the rest. LIFE IS A RIDE broke a step slow and outward, progressed from outside, was in close quarters three wide early into the second turn as she made her bid, moved clear for third leaving that bend, was no match for the top pair in the stretch but steadily pulled away for the show. MALIBU SUNRISE hustled along to set a pressured pace from inside, began to tire along the rail on the second turn. ALASKAN PARADOX chased from outside, angled in on the second turn, drifted out entering the lane and had little to offer. PRISSY RULER vied for the lead outside from the beginning, began to yield in close quarters into the second bend, gave way after five furlongs, was pulled up and walked off.
