COOL KID was soon clear, saved ground and held sway under steady urging in the lane. HEART OF KELA advanced between horses to vie for second three wide on the turn, was bumped at the head of the lane, battled to the wire for the place and narrowly prevailed. SOLO MIO raced closest to the leader from between rivals, was just off the rail on the bend, floated out a bit to bump HEART OF KELA at the top of the lane, lugged in some midstretch, fought gamely for the place but missed. STILL GREY a bit slow at the break, was bumped, progressed between horses, angled in leaving the bend, advanced along the rail, altered out three wide with a sixteenth left and continued to make up ground. LIFE IS A RIDE prominent from inside, gradually angled out leaving the turn, came four wide into the lane and found best stride too late. PURGING THE STONE was also away somewhat slowly and raced wide throughout. NITTANY LIONESS in midpack early, was four wide on the turn, angled in some entering the stretch and lacked a stretch bid. OMAR'S JEWEL broke slowly and inward, bumping STILL GREY, moved to the inside on the turn and failed to have a significant stretch response. KATIE'S WILD ONE a brief factor toward the outside, came five wide into the lane and gave way. ZWILLING soon faded between horses, had the rail on the turn, swung out some into the lane, moved in some for a clear path upper stretch and had little to offer.
