PAPER MAKER settled just off the inside, commenced his bid along the rail after a half mile, waited for room leaving the second turn, got through two wide upper stretch, gained a narrow lead between horses inside the final furlong and held off MILES AND MILES under steady urging. MILES AND MILES rated just outside PAPER MAKER through the early going, also went for the lead after a half mile, was two wide through the second bend, forced out some upper stretch, fought gamely to the wire but had to settle for second best. BOLD STANDARD vied for the lead from inside, moved clear on the backstretch, was challenged in the lane and gradually wore down the final sixteenth. ROY L. void of speed, came off the rail midway on the backstretch, progressed three and four wide through the second turn, altered in for a clear path upper stretch and improved his position some late. SON OF TIGER moved to the inside midway on the backstretch, made his bid three wide into the second turn, fanned out further entering the stretch and leveled off. TAXCO broke outward and failed to menace in a wide trip. ROCKET PROFESSOR was sent to contest the pace just outside BOLD STANDARD, could not stay with that one on the backstretch and faded two wide between horses after a half mile. MARKET MOVER soon trailed, was just off the inside taking the second turn and empty for the drive.
