**Footnotes**

TAPBDANCING away slowly, was rated inside, gradually picked up his pace, swung two wide for room on the second bend, altered out widest upper stretch, made a strong move the last eighth and was up in time. CHEROKEE SCOOTs showed first, set the pace from inside, moved clear upper stretch, slowly floated out as he began to weaken deep stretch and was outfinished. BOIS D'ARC FOREST pressed CHEROKEE SCOOTs from just outside, came to that one on the second turn, did not keep up into the stretch, gradually drifted out after entering the last furlong, held a straight path in the waning yards as he closed the gap but did not have enough nearing the wire. GIRLS CHOICE brushed with ROUGH ROAD at the break, moved to the outside on the backstretch, was three then four wide taking the second turn, gradually altered out as BOIS D'ARC FOREST came out deep stretch and also found best stride too late. GIVING POINTS hard sent to help prompt the pace three wide, moved to the rail on the second turn, was blocked upper stretch, got through from inside after entering the last furlong and was too late as well. ARTEMUS JOY bumped with AMORLI at the start, was rated from inside, commenced his bid along the rail on the second turn, was blocked inside the last furlong, altered out three wide with seventy yards left but was steadied as his path narrowed near the wire. RAP ON FELIX away slowly, gradually advanced two or three wide but could only make up minor ground the last furlong. ROUGH ROAD brushed with GIRLS CHOICE at the break, chased from between rivals, was three and four wide through the second turn and had no late bid. ELECTRIC STRIDE was soon widest, stayed well off the inside the rest of the way and had no stretch bid. AMORLI bumped with ARTEMUS JOY at the start and steadily faded from inside once on the backstretch.
