Footnotes

JUDGE FOR SALE away slowly, moved up between rivals, gained a slight advantage along the rail on the turn, floated out some into the stretch, battled two wide through the lane and edged ahead. JANE JUNIUR forwardly placed between horses, went for the lead three wide on the bend, fought outside JUDGE FOR SALE through the stretch, did not have enough late but moved clear for the place. MARY ANN'SMOMENT never far back, progressed along the rail on the turn, rallied from inside to vie for the lead in the stretch, could not sustain her bid late but was easily best of the rest. COLVILLE ZEAL forced out some as she vied for the early lead, was blocked behind LADY UMEANT early on the turn, backed up leaving the bend, had a clear path for the stretch run but no late bid. LADY UMEANT drifted out as she contested the early place, soon moved ahead, was overtaken from both sides on the turn, angled out four wide entering the stretch and continued to flatten out. TALK TO ME hit the gate as she broke on top, backed up between rivals shortly after and gave way four wide on the bend. UNDER THE VEIL soon trailed from outside, angled in entering the turn, drifted out in the lane, was eased late and walked off.
