Footnotes

OUR MOTEL was kept close not far off the inside, progressed between horses on the bend, swung out three wide into the lane, took over the lead, was clear with a sixteenth left, started to float out at that point, was corrected under a right whip and held on. NIXMIX without early foot from inside, angled into the turn, was steadied a couple times trying to maneuver through traffic on the bend, lost ground fanning six wide for the stretch run but closed well and just missed. MORNING MAN away slowly, was well back early, picked up his pace along the rail into the turn, squeezed through two wide at the quarter pole, angled outside OUR MOTEL upper stretch, gained second nearing the final sixteenth, altered out some as OUR MOTEL came out inside the sixteenth marker and was too late. A J'S PAYDAY was sent to dispute the pace between horses, three wide on the turn, angled in beside BOOK'S BLADE leaving the bend and gradually wore down the last eighth. BOOK'S BLADE set a pressured pace inside but weakened for the drive. OUR SHADE displayed early speed outside, lost ground five wide through the turn and flattened in the lane. ZZIP AWAY CAT was checked hard behind traffic leaving the five-furlong marker, swung to the outside into the turn, fanned widest into the stretch and lacked a rally. AMERICAN RACER prominent between horses on the backstretch, began to back up four wide on the turn, lugged in some nearing the quarter pole, crowding those inside, was corrected but continued to give way. WHITE SOCKS ROCK vied for the lead just outside BOOK'S BLADE, could not keep up on the turn, moved to the rail leaving the bend and flattened out. A LUCKY J contested the pace between horses, faded three wide early in the bend, angled in midway on the turn and had little left. There was a stewards' inquiry into ZZIP AWAY CAT'S loss of action early in the race but no action taken after their review.
