Footnotes

LOGOLD was rated off the rail through the early going, angled in entering the stretch, rallied under a left whip along the rail in the lane, gained the lead near the sixteenth marker and was driven clear. OURSECONDBUCK was hustled up along the rail to get the advantage a half mile out, drew clear on the turn, floated out a bit into the stretch, was all out in the drive, began to weaken late and just lasted for the place. PEPPERMINT ROAD pressed the early pace, was steadied in tight quarters near the half mile marker, chased OURSECONDBUCK from just outside, slowly closed the gap on that one in the lane but did not have enough late. MARCH HARE prompted the leaders from between rivals, bumped with TALK TO CHRISSY into the turn, backed up four wide on the bend and rallied belatedly in the lane. NICOLE M broke alertly, moved clear, was gradually angled inward, lost the lead three wide after two furlongs, backed up on the turn, raced evenly between rivals through the stretch and was outfinished. AGILE ALY made a leap from the gate, bobbled on her landing, was taken outside, raced in contention five to six wide but lacked the needed late response. TALK TO CHRISSY pressed the pacesetters from outside, bumped with MARCH HARE into the turn and gave way five wide shortly thereafter.
