Footnotes

KEYSTONE KID reluctant to load, vied for the lead from shortly after the race began, floated out some when roused nearing the quarter pole, was clear just off the inside entering the lane, steadily drew off and was kept to a drive until the last sixteenth. WHATITSTALLABOUT vied for the lead just outside KEYSTONE KID from the beginning, could not stay with that one leaving the second turn, gave futile chase under a drive in the stretch but moved clear for second inside the final furlong. ROARING REX somewhat slow at the start, was unhurried while along the rail on the first turn, gradually advanced just off the inside on the backstretch to gain third and a striking position on the second bend but could only hold his position deep stretch. ACE AFLEET showed first but was settled inside, swung out on the second bend, came four wide into the lane, passed tired ones upper stretch then finished evenly. FOXTROT OSCAR four wide on the first bend, raced in contention just off the inside on the backstretch, took the rail into the second turn and flattened out. HANDSOME MON pressed the pacesetters three wide, failed to keep up on the second turn, fanned out to path five entering the lane and steadily gave way.
