DEPOSIT EXPRESS set all the pace inside and prevailed with little urging. WILDWOOD PENNY, crowded and steadied leaving the gate, moved outside for room, advanced four wide through the turn and proved easily second best under a steady drive. SISTER SISTER broke to the inside and bumped with ABEL MISS DALLAS, improved her position three wide into the turn then raced evenly. SPEEDY TRINA angled out for room in the upper stretch, was put to a stern drive and improved her position late five wide. TREATWITHKIDGLOVES, fractious at the gate, broke toward the outside to bump with ABEL MISS DALLAS then failed to keep up inside. ABEL MISS DALLAS, bumped from both sides at the start, helped prompt the early pace from between horses but came up empty in the drive. AMATEUR took the turn five wide and drifted out badly into the stretch. COT DOT SUE hesitated at the start and was never close racing inside. TRAP THELAST TIGER angled out at the break, was steadied and showed little. FANNY MAY never threatened racing outside. The race was hand timed.
