Footnotes

TIP FROM SKIP settled and gradually angled in on the backstretch, saved ground through the turn, rallied along the rail in the lane, took the advantage seventy yards out and held on under urging. SMOKINEXPECTATIONS bumped shortly after the start, vied for the lead between rivals, was three then four wide taking the turn, floated out a bit inside the last furlong and found best stride too late. SHICAGO SENSATION contested the pace from inside, floated out some entering the stretch, battled gamely but did not have enough left inside the last sixteenth. UPPER CLASS POSH advanced inside on the turn, came off the rail some entering the lane, was blocked midstretch, altered out four wide for an opening with a sixteenth left but was steadied when his path narrowed near the wire. LINE I ONE dueled for the lead just outside SHICAGO SENSATION from the early going then slowly yielded the final sixteenth. GRUDGE MATCH prominent from outside, lost ground four then five wide taking the bend and could only make up minor ground deep stretch. IZZO lugged in some to bump SMOKINEXPECTATIONS shortly after the start, raced in contention toward the outside, began to tire three wide on the turn, swung widest entering the stretch and had little to offer.
