Footnotes

PIMM'S O'CLOCK rated off the inside, commenced his bid two wide on the turn, fanned out some for the stretch run, swiftly took the lead under a drive upper stretch and steadily opened up while kept to urging until the waning yards. FOXTROT OSCAR without early speed from inside, swung out five wide entering the stretch, had a striking position with a furlong to go but could only pull clear for second late. MYGRANDPAISADEACON chased the pacesetters from inside, was steadied while in tight leaving the turn, gradually altered out four wide upper stretch, battled for second but did not have enough late. WIRECLOUD bumped R RICH E. RICH at the break, trailed from outside, was just off the rail on the turn, swung widest for the drive, lodged a mild bid and narrowly missed for third. ALABAMA CLAY contested the pace from outside, was two wide into the stretch, no match for PIMM'S O'CLOCK and wore down inside the last furlong. SULTRY DEMEANOR displayed early speed from inside but gave way for the drive. R RICH E. RICH in midpack early from outside, faded three wide on the turn.
