MISCHIEF N MAYHEM soon had the lead just off the inside, moved clear on the bend then steadily opened up under urging in the lane. WILDWOOD BELLA pressed from inside, could not keep up with the leader on the turn, swung outside MISCHIEF N MAYHEM into the stretch, was no match for the latter but was unchallenged for the place. LITTLE NIBLETS away slowly, gradually progressed just off the rail, angled four wide for the stretch run and caught MAGGIE'S MONEY for third late. MAGGIE'S MONEY prominent from outside, could not stay close two wide leaving the turn, floated out some entering the lane and gradually lugged in as she slowly yielded. SWIFT MELVA chased just off the inside, had the rail on the turn and lacked a stretch bid. MIDNIGHT BRUISER soon retreated from between rivals, angled out widest on the turn and had little to offer for the drive. HONEY UNLIMITED was also away slowly, soon trailed from inside, angled out in the stretch but lacked a significant response. RENA M also soon retreated from outside on the backstretch, was just off the rail taking the bend, swung five wide for a clear path into the stretch but proved empty.
