JOYCE G settled just off the inside, commenced her bid after a half mile, angled out into the second turn, bumped with POLLY THE DOLLY leaving the quarter pole, came five wide into the stretch, gained the lead near the sixteenth marker then was driven clear. POLLY THE DOLLY advanced from outside on the backstretch, three then four wide on the second bend, bumped with JOYCE G while in tight quarters leaving that turn, progressed between rivals, altered out for room just inside the sixteenth marker and took over second late. GOLD CASE MOTEL rated off the early speed from inside, gained the lead along the rail leaving the second turn, was quickly clear, began to wear down inside the final furlong, drifted out some near the sixteenth marker and gradually backed up. PRETTI FROSTI settled at the back between rivals, closed the gap five wide on the second turn, fanned out further into the lane then steadily improved position without making up ground. CHARLOTTEOHARA in contention early three wide, went for the lead on the second turn but flattened out for the drive. KATHY'S LIL CAT void of speed off the inside, moved to the rail nearing the second turn, backed up along the rail on that bend and had little left through the stretch. PADDLE'S BIG GIRL sprinted clear, set the pace just off the inside, began to wear down going to the second turn, overtaken from both sides leaving that bend and quickly faded.
