OKLAHOMA NATURAL vied for the lead from inside, moved clear when asked leaving the turn and gradually opened up under urging in the lane. DEW DETIME contested the pace between horses from the beginning, was caught in tight quarters from the seven-sixteenths marker to midway on the turn, shuffled back some after that, came into the stretch just off the inside and steadily pulled away for the place. ATS GOOD never far off the inside, lacked a significant stretch response. STUDLEY DORIGHT dueled for the lead from outside, was three wide through the bend, gave way in the lane, took a bad step approaching the final sixteenth, was eased the rest of the way and walked off.
