FIERY SALSA broke alertly, was settled back, picked up her pace two wide on the second turn, moved to the rail in the upper stretch, squeezed through inside GO TORI GO midstretch, battled under a right, gained the advantage inside the final sixteenth and held on. DEVIOUS DIVA gradually progressed in tight quarters along the rail, was moved outside GO TORI GO in the upper stretch, dueled three wide the last eighth and caught the latter for second at the wire. GO TORI GO sprinted clear, held a commanding lead through the second turn, floated out a bit into the stretch, tried hard to hold on between rivals but was narrowly outfinished in a game effort. IRON MAIDEN TOO was rated inside through the early going, commenced her bid on the second turn, angled out leaving the bend, loomed a serious threat four wide midstretch but began to wear down late. BASKKET was void of speed off the rail, angled in on the second turn, made a strong move in the upper stretch to gain a striking position at the eighth pole but could not sustain her bid late. GRUVIANNA, three to five wide, failed to menace. CITY PRAYER showed little from outside. WAKI DAME chased GO TORI GO from just outside, faltered between horses into the second turn, was pulled up in the stretch and walked off.
