DENOUNCER'S GIRL broke alertly, was settled, progressed outside to threaten three wide on the turn, was carried out into the stretch, gradually closed the gap under a steady drive, gained the advantage a sixteenth out and slowly edged forward under continuous urging. SHE'S GOT ISSUES pressed ANGELAS BUTTERFLY from inside, altered outside that one when cut off into the turn, made her move two wide on the turn, drifted out into the stretch, drew clear, tried hard in the lane but had to settle for second best. DIAMOND LITTLE BIT was gradually angled inward nearing the turn, provided a mild bid in the stretch, only made up minor ground the last eighth but was clearly best of the rest. ANGELAS BUTTERFLY sprinted clear, was angled in to the rail into the turn, engaged by SHE'S GOT ISSUES on the bend and flattened out between rivals in the stretch. STAR STRETCHER was also gradually angled inward on the backstretch, steadied behind DIAMOND LITTLE BIT into the turn, fanned out five wide for the stretch run but lacked a late bid. ADDA DEVIL, three to four wide, was never a factor. TRADE N TREASURE pressed the pace briefly between rivals but gave way four wide on the turn.
