**Footnotes**

HALF MOON BEAUTY rated on the front end from paths two or three, moved clear on the backstretch, began to widen command when let out on the second bend, responded to mostly hand urging in the lane and continued to draw away. QUEEN OF THE MET broke outward, brushing WORTHY MISS, was settled just off the inside, commenced her bid nearing the second turn, moved clear for second on that bend, stayed in paths two or three as she gave futile chase through the lane but was easily second best. EASTERS DERBY GIRL soon backed up from inside, swung out leaving the first turn, came five wide into the backstretch, angled in on the second bend to be just off the rail, began to pass tired ones in the stretch and moved clear for third inside the final sixteenth. QUIET OUTLAW was soon well back, in path three on the backstretch, was roused nearing the second turn, took the rail into that bend, drew clear for third approaching the quarter pole, fanned outside QUEEN OF THE MET for the drive and gradually wore down deep stretch. ODEEODEE in paths four or five throughout, steadily faded. WORTHY MISS crowded briefly at the start, soon trailed, saved ground, showed little, collapsed on her walk back to her barn after the race and was vanned off. REBA NELL quickly moved up from outside after the break, gradually angled in beside HALF MOON BEAUTY on the first turn, could not stay with that one on the backstretch and gave way widest on the second turn.
