Footnotes

BACK JACK moved up to gain the lead from inside shortly after entering the main track, drew clear on the bend, held off TASIN TOM under a drive, his rider lost his whip just inside the seventy yard marker but finished well with hand urging. TASIN TOM showed first, was soon chasing BACK JACK from outside, was roused from just off the rail on the turn, all out in the stretch, could not close the gap on the leader but steadily opened up on the rest. NO NEWS forwardly placed between horses, could not stay with the top pair while three wide through the turn, ran evenly the last quarter mile and was not challenged for the show. GIBBY'S TORNADO jostled with DON'S WILL briefly leaving the chute, advanced from inside for four furlongs then leveled off. DON'S WILL jostled with GIBBY'S TORNADO shortly after the break, was void of speed from not far off the inside, fanned out to path three for the drive and had no late bid. FRIO FLYER in contention from outside on the backstretch, gave way four wide on the bend. POWER WOW soon trailed and was taken inside, saved ground taking the turn and had little response under slight hand urging in the stretch.
