Footnotes

NAFIR'S BEST rated on the front end just outside SHESTOYOUNGFORUBRO, was put to a drive on the second turn, drew clear upper stretch and continued to lengthen command while kept to task to the wire. WIN DOUGH REID unruly in the gate, was settled, advanced just off inside on the backstretch, had the rail on the second bend, angled out some entering the lane, moved outside NAFIR'S BEST at the top of the lane, gained second with a furlong to go, moved clear for that position approaching the final sixteenth, was all out in the late going and narrowly held the place. FLY BO FLY trailed from off the rail, picked up his pace into the second turn, split rivals three wide with a quarter mile to go, angled out some into the lane, steadily advanced, just missed for second but was clearly best of the others. SHESTOYOUNGFORUBRO contested the pace from inside but began to wear down in the stretch. HOT NEEDLE without speed from inside, was steadied as his path narrowed approaching the quarter pole, kept in hand as he squeezed through along the rail entering the lane, came off the rail a bit upper stretch and lacked a rally. COURT COMPOSER gradually faded running widest. BLACKHAWK RED pressed the early speed from just outside but gave way just off the rail on the second turn.
