Footnotes

BELLA MICHELLE bounced off MAKE HER A STAR at the break and into COUSIN HALEY and JOEFINE, was lated from inside, angled out on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, closed strongly and swept past MISS BOCEPHUS and SECA TREACE the last seventy yards. MISS BOCEPHUS prominent between rivals from the beginning, vied for the lead from path three on the bend, battled with a slight advantage in the lane, was no match for BELLA MICHELLE in the late going but edged ahead for the place. SECA TREACE quickly moved up from inside to contest the pace, was just off the inside through the turn, battled gamely in the stretch but did not have enough left and had to settle for third. JOEFINE broke inward, bumped COUSIN HALEY then with BELLA MICHELLE, was settled at the back, had the rail on the turn, floated out to path five into the lane, altered in some for a clear path upper stretch and closed well but too late. MAKE HER A STAR bumped with BELLA MICHELLE at the start, raced in contention off the inside, failed to keep up along the rail on the turn, regained a striking position upper stretch, came off the inside deep stretch but could not sustain her bid. JULIA'S SONG pressed the early speed from outside, lost ground staying five wide through the turn and gradually wore down for the drive. VELVET ACCOUNT was a factor toward the outside on the backstretch but faded four wide on the bend. STILETTO HEELS broke in the air, raced in contention between horses, three wide through the turn then flattened out in the stretch. COUSIN HALEY broke outward, was squeezed hard between rivals, checked, stayed well off the inside most of the way and showed little. DUCHESS OF DENT displayed early speed between horses, faded two wide on the turn, was pulled up sore deep stretch and walked off.
