Footnotes

DENO'S BIRDIE steadied behind traffic nearing the first turn, was settled the first half, commenced his bid two wide on the second turn, altered out five wide for room midstretch, took the lead nearing the sixteenth marker and was drawing off. TIO CHENCHO vied for the lead inside from the beginning, jostled lightly with FOX RAP leaving the second turn and into the lane, moved ahead upper stretch, could not hold off DENO'S BIRDIE the final sixteenth but was easily second best. PRESENTS FOR BERTI moved to the inside near the half mile marker, came off the rail some on the second turn, fanned four wide into the stretch, had a striking position with a furlong to go but could only pull away for third late. FOX RAP stumbled as he broke on top, shared the lead outside from the start, jostled lightly with TIO CHENCHO leaving the second turn, could not keep up nearing midstretch and flattened out the last eighth. DR SWIFT failed to menace in a wide trip. SMOKEY AROMA displayed brief speed between horses, gradually yielded on the backstretch, had the rail on the second turn and was empty for the drive. A FLEETING MEMORY a step slow at the break, was soon well back, save ground on the second turn, floated out entering the stretch and had little to offer. BARRY K steadily faded from between rivals.
