POLITICAL ERA drew off from the rest on the first turn, was relaxed on the backstretch, challenged into the second turn, quickly shook off the competition when roused shortly after that, lengthened command under hand urging in the stretch and was put to a drive inside the last sixteenth. INDY LAD raced closest to POLITICAL ERA from just off the inside, commenced his bid after a half mile to threaten two wide entering the second bend, could not keep up leaving the turn but steadily drew off for second through the lane. J COOL unhurried and taken inside going to the first turn, gradually picked up his pace on the backstretch, progressed outside rivals on the second bend, came five wide into the lane and drew away for the show inside the final sixteenth. SOUTHERN DREAMER advanced from outside to gain a striking position three wide nearing the second turn, was no match for the top pair leaving that bend and wore down inside the last eighth. NAJFIVE chased from between horses, also came into contention nearing the second bend, failed to keep up three wide leaving that turn, had no stretch bid, was angled outside SOUTHERN DREAMER approaching the sixteenth marker then drifted out further. DEWISE a step slow at the start, was taken inside on the first turn, showed no speed, steadied some when his path narrowed leaving the second bend, continued to stay inside and had no late bid. NEWBOLD GOLD chased from inside, also closed the gap on the leader nearing the second turn but began to tire as he gradually angled out through that bend, came four wide into the stretch and continued to fade.
