Footnotes

MY DOMINICK JAMES bumped from the rear at the start, soon shared the lead from inside, drew away when roused upper stretch and was under wraps inside the final sixteenth. MILITARY LEGEND bumped and forced into BIG SMOOTH at the break, was settled between horses, three wide through the bend, altered inside MR. CART deep stretch and took over second. BIG SMOOTH bumped and forced into MY DOMINICK JAMES at the start, was settled inside, commenced his bid leaving the turn, wove in and out several times to advance in traffic and caught MR. CART for third near the wire. MR. CART was sent to contest the pace between horses, moved to the rail into the bend, swung three wide for the stretch run, gained second, was no match for MY DOMINICK JAMES the final furlong and gradually wore down. FAST ALBERT broke inward, starting a chain reaction of bumping, trailed from outside and only passed a couple tired rivals while widest late. CAPT. BULLET BOB disputed the pace from outside, angled in two wide leaving the turn and flattened in the lane. RAY JAY was a brief contender, failed to stay close along the rail on the turn, altered outside BIG SMOOTH upper stretch and continued to give way.
