Footnotes

INDIAN MOONSHINE steadied back from crowding just after the break, was settled inside, slowly advanced along the rail, angled out nearing the quarter pole, came four wide into the lane, rallied under a stern drive, gained the advantage with a sixteenth to go and edged ahead with steady urging. STONEHOUSE bumped into the first turn, soon shared the lead from outside, drew clear on the second bend, moved to the inside leaving that turn, widened upper stretch, was all out the rest of the way, did not have enough late but was easily second best. GUCCIONE bumped STONEHOUSE into the first bend, contested the pace, was in tight between BOLD STANDARD and STONEHOUSE early in the second turn, could not stay with the latter going to the quarter pole, floated out some entering the stretch, his rider lost the whip nearing the eighth pole, gradually backed up but was unchallenged for third. BULLBUCK jostled briefly with OUST after the break, was well placed inside for six furlongs, began to fade into the lane, moved to the outside midstretch and had little left. OUST jostled with BULLBUCK after the start, moved up to contention from path three on the backstretch, was just off the rail on the second turn, swung out five wide for the stretch run and was empty. INSTILL two to four wide most of the way, failed to menace. BOLD STANDARD displayed early speed just off the rail but gave way in the stretch.
