Footnotes

KATIE'S LADY prominent three wide from the beginning, went for the lead on the turn, was carried out some leaving the bend, battled through the stretch and edged ahead in the late going. CHASE IT sent to the lead under an early whip, showed the way just of the inside, was challenged while still just off the rail on the turn, floated out some entering the stretch, headed nearing the eighth pole, did not relent in a game effort but had to settle for second best. GOLDMINE PRINCESS in contention between rivals on the backstretch, took over third three wide on the turn, fanned out some into the lane, angled out to path five upper stretch, was no match for the top pair and narrowly lasted for the show. ROKEE broke inward, was steadied, was soon well back just off the inside, began to swing out nearing the quarter pole, floated out to path six entering the stretch, was widest as she passed tired ones and was getting to GOLDMINE PRINCESS late. TOUGH TALKIN ANNIE chased from outside, angled in on the bend and gradually wore down the last eighth. WILD SHADES came in beside ROKEE early on, was in path three on the bend, was just off the inside for most of the stretch run had no late bid. I BE FREE displayed brief speed from inside, gave way along the rail leaving the turn, distanced herself from the field through the stretch and was walked off.
