### Footnotes

SPIRIT OFMOONSHINE kept close from outside, angled in on the turn, took the lead along the rail upper stretch, edged ahead then held off CELIA SUE under a steady drive. CELIA SUE was bumped from the rear on one side and crowded from the other at the break, recovered to vie for the lead from outside, did not keep up four wide on the turn, angled in some for the drive, gradually closed the gap on SPIRIT OFMOONSHINE, came up a bit short but was easily second best. RUN CRYSTAL RUN stumbled badly at the start then bumped CELIA SUE, moved to the inside near the half mile pole, was checked behind SPIRIT OFMOONSHINE nearing the quarter pole, continued inside, lacked a rally but moved clear for third late. STRIPED AFFAIR broke inward, bumping PURR YADDA, set a pressured pace just off the inside, moved clear on the turn but wore down for the drive. DANCING DERVISH broke awkwardly, was soon well back, saved ground taking the turn, angled out upper stretch then gradually drifted out. PURR YADDA bumped and forced into CELIA SUE at the start, recovered to dispute the pace between horses but began to tire three wide leaving the bend.
