Footnotes

MARJORIE V. stalked the early leader from outside, closed the gap four wide on the turn, got a narrow advantage in the upper stretch, lugged in some near the eighth pole, dueled SHAKE THECHAMPAGNE to the wire and held on. SHAKE THECHAMPAGNE pressed PHONE JOAN outside from the early going, went for the lead two wide on the turn, had a brief lead at the head of the lane, lost the advantage shortly after that, never relented the last eighth but had to settle for second best. PRINCESS FIONA was kept close early behind PHONE JOAN, angled out three wide for room on the turn, moved outside MARJORIE V. midstretch, closed well and got up for third late. PHONE JOAN set the pace inside to the head of the lane then began to wear down. MISS DAN PAT showed first but was quickly outrun and trailed the rest of the way running widest of all.
