TOTAL OFFENSE drifted out after the break, bumped BOBS LAST HOPE, was kept close between horses, two to three wide through the bend, steadied behind FRIAR'S POINT into the stretch, altered in two wide once straightened in the lane, gained the advantage nearing the sixteenth pole and was driven clear. NIXMIX broke inward, was hustled up between rivals to press the early speed from outside, three to five wide through the turn and caught FRIAR'S POINT for second near the wire. FRIAR'S POINT bumped, then leaned on BOBS LAST HOPE some at the break, set the pace off the rail, stayed off the rail on the turn, in path three entering the stretch, could not stay with TOTAL OFFENSE inside the final furlong and lugged in some as he weakened. BOOK'S BLADE raced in contention early from outside, backed up three wide on the turn, also fanned out five wide into the stretch, was blocked, altered in four wide at the furlong pole, had a striking position but leveled off late. BOBS LAST HOPE, bumped then pinched at the start, was checked, trailed off the rail, three wide on the bend, lacked the needed response between horses and altered in late trying to stay clear of FRIAR'S POINT. A LUCKY J, fractious behind the gate, advanced inside on the turn, closed the gap some in the upper stretch, did not have enough late and was blocked through the waning yards.
