Footnotes

LONG DRAW bumped from the rear at the break, was rated from inside, angled out into the second turn, took over the lead, moved clear when asked entering the lane, steadily drew off and proved much the best ridden out. HOLY FEVER broke a step slow and inward, bumping LONG DRAW, was steadied slightly, split rivals two wide leaving the first turn to gain the lead, moved clear on the backstretch, was overtaken from outside on the second bend, no match for LONG DRAW in the stretch, was all out the last eighth and lasted for the place. FORREST RIDES without early speed, though urged along, gradually progressed along the rail, moved clear for third on the second turn, came off the inside some for the stretch run and was getting to HOLY FEVER late. FATHERS BAD BOY wide through the first bend, gradually moved inside on the backstretch, saved ground taking the second turn and lacked a late bid. EL POO showed first, contested the pace briefly from between horses, began to fade three wide on the backstretch, was just off the inside taking the second turn and empty for the drive. MI C YOU N IOWA displayed early speed from outside, gradually yielded on the backstretch, had little left the last three furlongs, distanced himself from the field and was walked off.
