Footnotes

MYGRANDPAISADEACON urged along off the rail, took the inside on the bend, gradually angled out through the stretch, was all out in the late going and got up nearing the wire. FOXTROT OSCAR without early speed from inside, came off the rail some entering the lane, made a strong move, split rivals two wide approaching the wire and got second. NORTHERN GUY steadily progressed from inside, battled on even terms with CAVANAUGH deep stretch, did not have enough in the waning yards and was outfinished in a game effort. CAVANAUGH soon had the advantage between rivals, floated out some entering the stretch, battled gamely between rivals, but also did not have enough nearing the wire. WIRECLOUD was also without early speed while just off the inside, swung out four wide for the stretch run, also gradually angled out to stay clear of MYGRANDPAISADEACON the last eighth and was steadied slightly nearing the finish. LOGAN'SSHOREBREEZE trailed running widest and found best stride too late in the lane. LUCKY ALEC pressed from outside, could not keep up three wide on the turn, drifted out some into the stretch and steadily faded between horses.
