Footnotes

OURSECONDBUCK steadily angled in going for the lead, crowding those inside, moved clear with little asking on the turn, widened the gap through the drive, was drifting out late and put to a corrective right whip. ROBERTA EMPRESS was blocked between horses on the turn, brushed with BEALE ST. looking for room outside leaving the quarter pole, got through four wide entering the stretch, was no match for the winner but proved clearly second best. ANGELS VALENTINE chased the winner three wide through the turn and lacked a stretch rally between horses. MARYETT was carried in leaving the chute, forced to check inside in tight quarters into the turn, made a mild bid in the upper stretch to challenge briefly for the place but weakened late. SISTER SISTER was steadily carried in by OURSECONDBUCK through the backstretch, proved unresponsive to the whip on the turn and flattened out between horses in the drive. BEALE ST. failed to keep up four wide on the turn, was brushed by ROBERTA EMPRESS leaving the quarter mile marker and lacked a stretch bid outside. DAWN'S DARLING was carried in leaving the chute, bumped with ROBERTA EMPRESS entering the main track, lost her path and forced to check back hard shortly thereafter, taken outside and showed little.
