Footnotes

GOLD CASE MOTEL showed first, was rated from inside, went for the lead along the rail on the second turn, took over leaving that bend and widened command under a drive through the stretch. MEHO ROUGE sprinted clear, showed the way just off the inside, floated out some into the stretch, was no match for the winner but easily best of the rest. PRETTI FROSTI chased MEHO ROUGE from between horses, three wide with a quarter mile to go, fanned outside the latter for the stretch run, weakened, drifted out late but held her position. JOYCE G was soon far back, picked up her pace after a half mile, saved ground through the second turn and passed tired ones in the lane. POLLY THE DOLLY was hustled from the gate, steadied in traffic on the first turn, helped prompt the pace between horses, gained the inside entering the second turn, failed to stay close, in path two entering the lane and had little to offer. SEA DREAMER in contention early from outside, did not stay close navigating the second bend four to six wide and flattened out for the drive. MINE ATLAST was a factor, running widest, on the backstretch, dropped from contention five wide on the second turn, angled in some entering the stretch and was empty. MOON SHINE TIME stumbled at the start and lost her rider. There was a stewards' inquiry into the start but no action taken.
