Footnotes

BETTER SAFE kept close, waited for room from inside on the turn, got through along the rail into the lane, took over midstretch and was drew off under a drive. LADIES DRINK FREE caught in crowding at the start, jostled with CAMP FAIRFAX R N, was steadied, was three wide on the turn, lost ground fanning to path six for the drive, could not close the gap on the leader the last eighth but started to draw clear for second late. LADY DI'S DREAMER in contention early, was just off the rail on the bend, forced to fan five wide for room into the stretch, lacked a significant bid but caught HOPEFUL SWEEPER for third near the wire. HOPEFUL SWEEPER disputed the pace between horses, gained the rail and moved ahead on the turn, floated out some entering the stretch, could not hold off BETTER SAFE inside the final furlong and slowly yielded. CAMP FAIRFAX R N also caught in crowding at the break, jostled briefly with LADIES DRINK FREE, advanced from inside on the turn, swung four wide entering the lane, had to alter her path three times inside the final furlong and was checked near the wire. POSH LADY broke outward, raced in the second flight from outside, three then four wide taking the bend, began to wear down inside the last furlong and altered out when crowded by CAMP FAIRFAX R N near the finish. CHASE IT in contention from inside on the backstretch, did not stay close leaving the turn and found best stride too late deep stretch. CANDY PASS altered in some just after the break to crowd those inside her, soon moved to the outside, swung widest into the stretch and showed some late interest. OLIVE CAN displayed early speed just outside HOPEFUL SWEEPER, began to quit between rivals at the top of the lane, was eased deep stretch and walked off.
