Footnotes

RIDGEWAY ANGEL showed first, was rated between horses, moved clear nearing the bend, stayed just off the rail through the turn, floated out entering the stretch, gradually drifted out the last sixteenth but maintained full control under hand urging. CROSSWISE soon moved to the inside, progressed through the turn, battled for second in the lane and shook off CORNER GIRL late. CORNER GIRL prominent outside the early speed, gradually angled out taking the bend, came five wide into the stretch, fought for the place but did not have enough left the last sixteenth. LUCKY TIP soon trailed, was just off the inside leaving the bend, gradually angled out through the stretch and improved her position without threatening. STRONG N TRUE displayed early speed inside RIDGEWAY ANGEL, could not stay with that one nearing the turn, fanned out some leaving the bend and gradually yielded from between rivals. SHINY STAR raced in contention between horses on the backstretch but faded three wide on the turn. SASHITA showed little in a wide trip.
