Footnotes

CAMAGIN bumped WONDER COUNTRY at the start, was rated on the front end just off the inside, drew off when allowed on the turn, responded to slight hand urging in the lane and continued to widen her authority over the rest. BELLA MICHELLE in contention early FROM INSIDE, could not stay close to the leader on the turn, took over second while all out in the lane, floated out a bit midstretch and could only just hold her position late. WONDER COUNTRY bumped from both sides at the break, was settled just off the inside, advanced along the rail on the turn, was blocked behind BELLA MICHELLE upper stretch, got through after entering the last furlong, steadily made up ground on the latter but was too late. SWIFT MELVA an early factor between horses, came three wide into the stretch and found best stride belatedly. HERE'S DENTON pressed from outside, did not stay with CAMAGIN on the turn, was four wide entering the lane and lacked the extra needed deep stretch. DONTFLATERYOURSELF settled at the back, stayed well off the inside taking the turn then passed between tired ones in the stretch. COOL GRETA broke inward, also bumping WONDER COUNTRY, raced closest to the pacesetter from just outside then gradually wore down between rivals in the lane. SUNDAY DREAMS broke somewhat slowly then was forced out, ran wide throughout and failed to menace. TAP DAZZLER hopped outward at the break, advanced toward the outside but gave way four wide on the turn.
